JUTE Theatre Company is dedicated to developing, producing and touring new, diverse and vibrant theatre and to the capacity building of regional theatre practitioners. JUTE strives to make Far North Qld a leader in regional artistic theatre practice and is committed to cultivating meaningful experiences and connections with our audiences onstage and offstage across regional and remote communities.

The Dare to Dream First Nations Tour and Residency program tours annually to 10 regional and remote communities for 10 weeks. IN 2021 JUTE will add 5 weeks of touring to this and JUTE is also working towards a doubling of this program to reach more communities into the future. JUTE commissions, develops and produces new work each year to populate these touring programs with all First Nations casts and crew. The Dare to Dream program would be the main focus of the Creative Producer.

Selection Criteria

To be successful in this role you will need to have

- Significant hands-on experience and understanding of working collaboratively with First Nations cultures and communities, within the theatre sector;
- Significant experience in producing and presenting contemporary performing arts events, with specific skills and experience developing and delivering First Nations led projects, from commission to performance and touring.
- Demonstrated high-level written and oral communication skills.
- Significant experience in project management of complex arts projects from concept stage through to completion; including scoping and managing project budgets and resources.
- Experience establishing networks and maintaining effective relationships with Indigenous Elders, community, stakeholders and industry.
- Extensive contacts in the First Nations performing arts industry.
- Model a positive and inclusive practice with a range of people from diverse backgrounds including First Nations people.

The position is based at JUTE's home at Bulmba-Ja Arts Centre, Cairns.

The successful applicant will be required to apply/hold a Working with Children blue card.
